The Bible adds this: "The wise man's eyes are in his head, but the fool walks in darkness. Yet I myself perceived that the same event happens to them all" (Eccl. 2:14). That last verse says 1) Foolish eyes wander unfocused and in darkness, and 2) Many things happen alike to the wise and the unwise; and whether or not they love and obey God. Is it possible to be intelligent and quite or even *very* focused, yet still be a "fool" or unwise in the long term?

Jeremiah the prophet was amazingly faithful to both God and man. He tried to warn the king and his fellow-Jews, but they wouldn't listen. He addressed his words, at times, in this way: "Hear now this, O foolish people, and without understanding; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not" (Jer. 5:21). "Foolish people" don't necessarily lack education, natural ability or resolve.

The record of **this favoured man, named Balaam,** is mainly given in "the 4th book of Moses, called "Numbers," chapters 22-24. Reference to this *especially*-unusual man, Balaam, is also found elsewhere in the Bible.

In Num. 22, God "opened the eyes" of this man who was dangerously blind to his personal sin. He was blind to how much God hates sin—especially when God had been coming into his life (even though he was not Israeli!). He was also blind to the damning consequences of his personal sin. God took the blinders away! What a favour this is, when God does this for a person! In Num. 24, as he prepared to speak God's truth and reveal some of God's foretelling, Balaam referred to himself four times as "the man whose eyes God opened."

The tragedy of tragedies is that Balaam ended up fighting against God, though God had truly opened his eyes! He died in that rebelling, compromising, betraying condition, though he had openly stated his praiseworthy desire in the prayer: "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like his!" (23: 10).

Many people, in their most sensible moments, have this same desire. None but God knows the true spiritual condition of a person's heart, including when they are dying. For many, death comes suddenly, with no time to pray. For many others...even facing death..., there is (or seems to be) no inclination to seek God and His forgiveness. Then, too, many are so drugged-up in hospital due to their physical condition...perhaps terminally ill...that they seem totally incapable of praying. Yet, innumerable people, freely walking the pavements, are as drugged-up, but with Balaam-like allurements blinding them and keeping them detoured from truly obeying God.

Balaam said that God had opened his eyes. God had! Many people today... many here in London...have had God to give them glimpses of reality, just like Balaam. If you dress up scary later in the year, at Halloween, just forget all well-known scary models. There is no scarier model than Balaam, whose eyes were opened by God, who openly stated the best eternal goal, but who died in antagonism against God. Yet most people walk in his skin all year, not just in October.

About 27 years ago, our GP told me some of the moral, philosophical, hairsplitting "helps" to decision-making found, as I recall, in the Jewish Talmud. He gave an example, asking "Which person should own a particular object: the one who picked it up, or he who actually saw it first?" I guess I was supposed to be impressed. He also stated his opinion that if Jesus came to bring "peace on earth," then He failed. The poor GP himself *failed*— 1) to have Godopened eyes when reading Scripture itself, and 2) by elevating and glorying in the Talmud instead. This same GP, standing at our bedside as my wife was in labour, told us bluntly: "This baby is dead." The GP was *"dead wrong," and we knew it. He was *"dead wrong" about Jesus, too.

The point of my sharing, above, is that <u>Balaam saw the star first</u>! He saw it through the "telescope of prophecy," over 14 centuries before the wise men. **But Dr. Balaam was "dead wrong"** to take the course of action that he chose. He gambled and lost. The "late-comer" wise men, didn't gamble—they obeyed! *And* they obeyed *God*, not King Herod.

Herod and Balaam had the same spirit and heart. Herod killed children in the vain attempt to stop and silence God. Balaam tried to kill his donkey, that was trying to save his life and his soul. Yes, Balaam saw the star long before the wise men, but he failed to follow as *they* did. Be *truly* wise, with open eyes... AND obedient heart and ready feet!

*NOTE: The term, "dead wrong," (above) simply means "completely wrong."

urch 5:45 To walk in loving obedience to God is a Way of Life that has been attacked since the Garden of Eden. From the Garden of Eden to the New Testament Book of Acts, that fight continued. It still rages today.

Satan wasted no time trying to destroy God's work in the first century. He had done the same in The Garden of Eden. The first century apostle warned those early believers of the teaching being spread of another Jesus... another Gospel... another Spirit" (2 Cor. 11; 4 & Gal. 1:6-8). "Counterfeit Christs," preached in the first century, were spread in later centuries and are still being promoted today.

A similar thing appears to have happened with the Star that led the wise men to the Christ Child, which had been foretold by Balaam (mentioned in the front page article). The prophet, Amos, like the other Bible prophets, recorded God's faithful, "zero-tolerance" judgement upon Israel's sins, as well as His loving pleas for their repentance and return. Listen to God's rebuke from Amos 5:

21"I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell the sweet fragrances in your solemn assemblies. 22 Though you offer Me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts. 23 Take away from Me the noise of your songs; for I will not hear the melody of your viols.24 But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream. 25 Have you offered unto Me sacrifices and offerings in the wilderness forty years, O house of Israel?26 But you have carried

the portable shrine of your Moloch and Chiun your images, the star of your god, which you made to yourselves. 27 Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, says the LORD, whose name is The God of

hosts." Wow, that is powerful!

God is completely disgusted at religious "worship" carried out in vain show, empty ritualism or froth, and hypocrisy. That goes for sacrifices, music, the whole thing. God is no less appalled at the various ways He is treated by the non-religious crowd—ignored, mocked, denied, neglected. But it was not with religious hypocrites in mind that God asks, "For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? Now, if the righteous one is scarcely saved, where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" (1 Pet. 4: 17, 18).

The world is predominantly following "another star." The TYPE of that "other star," is irrelevant. Jesus clearly stated "No person can serve two masters!" Many professing Christians of all sorts, and non-Christians as well, need to take Christ's words seriously. The "herd" follow "another star" and its beams of apparently-fulfilling pleasure. "Stars," celebrities, business big-shots and high politicians linked together not long ago in obvious and planned agreement in bold, public support of ways of life (relating to sex and marriage) that directly defy God.

"Angel-faced" Stephen confirmed the history of **Israel's idolatrous star worship** as he confronted the guilty religionists (Acts 6: 15; 7: 42, 43). For his faithfulness to both God and man, he paid with his life, but prayed for those who killed him, just as Jesus had done (v.60). **Stephen followed** *THE* **Star... not** "another star"... and **pointed us all to It.** * **Look and Live!**
